## SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT SERVICES FOR LYNWOOD BUSINESSES AND MULTI-FAMILY PROPERTIES

State law requires all businesses that regularly generate four (4) or more cubic yards of waste weekly and all multi-family complexes (5+ units) to <u>recycle</u>. This can be accomplished a few ways:

- self-haul to a recycling facility;
- subscribe to a hauler's recycling service;
- sell or donate recyclables;
- subscribe to a recycling service that includes mixed waste processing (the recycling is done for you).

Waste Resources provides mixed waste processing for Lynwood, but it may be to your advantage to subscribe to a separate recycling service for paper, plastic, glass, and metals. Call our office to discuss your options.

State law also requires certain businesses and multi-family complexes (5+ units) to recycle their <u>organic waste</u>, based on the amount generated per week. Organic waste includes food scraps, landscape and pruning waste, and nonhazardous wood waste. The threshold for compliance is occurring in phases until 2020. Call our office for more information and to find out if/when you need to comply with this law.
