## (Residential and Multi-Family Sector)

### Food Scraps (must be bagged in <u>clear</u> bags only):

- All fruits and vegetables (pits and shells are permitted)
- ✓ Pasta, grains, rice, beans
- ✓ Coffee grounds and loose tea
- Cheese and dairy products
- ✓ Eggshells and eggs
- ✓ Leftovers and spoiled food
- ✓ Meats and bones
- ✓ Seafoods and soft shells
- Breads and pastries

#### ✓ Food-Soiled Paper:

- ✓ Coffee filters and tea bags
- ✓ Paper cups, bags, trays, and plates
- ✓ Paper egg cartons
- Paper ice cream containers
- Paper napkins, tissues and paper towels

- Biodegradable paper serviceware (100% paper)

#### Green Waste and other Organics (must be loose):

- ✓ Grass clippings, leaves, and flowers
- ✓ Small branches (less than 3 inches thick and 4 feet long)
- ✓ Untreated, clean wood scraps
- Lumber, scrap wood, & plywood (not painted or treated)
- ✓ Weeds
- ✓ Wet cardboard

## Mixed Organics Collection Program (Commercial Sector)

#### Food Scraps (examples):

- All fruits and vegetables (pits and shells are permitted)
- ✓ Pasta, grains, rice, beans
- ✓ Coffee grounds and loose tea
- Cheese and dairy products
- Eggshells and eggs
- ✓ Leftovers and spoiled food
- ✓ Meats\* (including bones)
- Seafoods\* (excluding large concentrations of shellfish)
- Breads and pastries

- ✓ Food-Soiled Paper (in limited amounts):
  - ✓ Coffee filters and tea bags
  - ✓ Paper cups, bags, trays, and plates
  - ✓ Paper egg cartons
  - ✓ Paper ice cream containers (metal rim is OK)
  - Paper napkins, tissues and paper towels
  - Greasy pizza boxes and paper
  - Biodegradable paper serviceware (100% paper)
  - ✓ Paper bags
  - ✓ Wooden and fiber-based utensils

#### Materials allowed:

- Organics in loose form
- ✓ Organics in clear bags and packaging used for organics waste (but no plastic wrap/bags inside it)
- ✓ Organics in their original packaging of paper, plastic, Tetra Pak's or metal (pre-consumer) or spoiled and expired food (up to 3 gallon)
- ✓ Wet cardboard
- ✓ Styrofoam or plastic take-out containers (with clamshell hinged lids or dome lids) of any size and shape (note these should be limited)
